

Reception Daily Timetable

Phonics 30 mins	<p>Phonics videos are set on Google Classroom. You will recognise these as ones that have been sent to you before. Each day you will have a set of videos to follow which will take around 30 minutes. Please follow these with your child, they are also very useful for you to understand what they are learning and how they are learning to read and write.</p> <p>Please practice after the phonics videos writing the sound/words.</p> <p>You can also use the green words provided to you in their packs to practice reading and writing.</p>
Maths 30 mins	<p>Everyday you child will have a maths session video with a follow up activity. You can find all of this on Google Classroom. After you have done this there is also a daily Maths Challenge for you to do. There is also linked sheets to week that you can follow with.</p> <p>Please upload any pictures of their amazing maths to google Classroom.</p>
Independent Reading 15 mins	<p>Please make sure you regularly log in to Bug Club. If you need a reminder of your log in please just email me. I have allocated your child at least 10 different books to their level. These are the same as their reading books that are sent home but just electronic versions. Please read each book 3/4 times. You should aim for your child to read to you for 15 minutes every day and you to read to your child for 15 minutes every day. When they are reading try to get your child to do this as independently as possible. You can help them if needed and try to ask lots of questions around the story to help their understanding.</p>
Storytime 15 mins	<p>There are now Reading Books and eBooks on Google Classroom.</p> <p>We will also have a bedtime story read by one of our adults at 5pm every day!</p>
Activities	<p>On Google Classroom you will find a range of fun activities that you can do at home with your child linking to the topic we are learning about. Some of these will have challenges for you to complete. These can vary in time and depending on how much fun they are having!</p>
